## **BIB 107: Revelation**

[1/3 Credit Hour(s)]

### **Instructor:**

### **Course Description:**

This course is designed to give students a comprehensive understanding of the Book of Revelation. The class will focus on the historical, archaeological, and geopolitical setting of this writing. The student will engage in a verse by verse study of this book. Emphasis will be given to the style of writing and the intended message for the Church of yesterday and today.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

1. The Student will be able to discuss the authorship of the book, the period of history in which it was written, and major/minor themes found throughout.
2. The student will be able to discuss the meaning of symbols in the book.
3. The student will gain an understanding of the various methods of interpretation and the foundational philosophies which guide each camp.
4. The student will be able to engage the “difficult passages” of this book.
5. The student will come to understand the timeless messages found in Revelation.
